ENHANCING TRANSIT ALONG 27th STREET

Milwaukee County Transit System (MCTS) has begun the environmental review and design phase for the North-South Transit Enhancement project.

The project will deploy bus rapid transit (BRT) service along the 27th Street corridor currently served by the PurpleLine and is the second route planned for MCTS's CONNECT BRT system. Design plans are just beginning, and outreach will continue to be important during this phase with opportunities for the local communities and the public to provide input on many aspects of the project.
